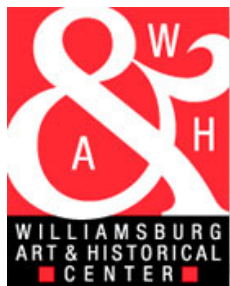
Submission Fee *To honor our dedicated volunteers, there is no entry fee for this show.*

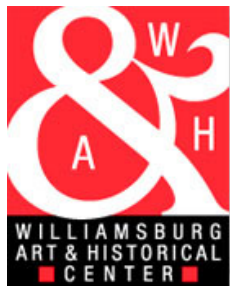

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Instruction Details for Accepted Artists

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REQUIREMENTS FOR ACCEPTED WORK:

- 1) A completed entry form (please see attachments)
- 2) Please have work signed (and numbered, if applicable)
- 3) Accepted works should be framed (unless otherwise arranged)
- 4) A label must be affixed to the back of the work, indicating which end is the top and the following: Artist's Name, Title, Medium, Dimensions, Date Produced, Edition # (if applicable), and Sale Price. This information must correspond to the submitted works listed on the completed entry form
- 5) We do not accept pieces too fragile to handle
- 6) Works cannot be withdrawn before the end of the exhibition

DELIVERY INSTRUCTIONS:

Hand Delivery Date: Saturday, September 9th, 12-6pm & Sunday, September 10th, 12-6pm

Deliver works to side entrance on Bedford Avenue:

- 1) Ring bell for admittance
- 2) Bring artwork to the 2nd floor gallery & check in at reception desk
- 3) Artwork must be clearly labeled on the front and back
- 4) Take all wrapping materials with you, as we do not have additional storage space

Please arrange to have works arrive on or before Sunday, September 10th

EXHIBITION BINDER:

For viewers interested in knowing more about the exhibiting artists, we compile an exhibition binder containing information of participating artists. We ask for the following in plastic protective sheets (USA standard 8.5" x11" with 3 punched holes):

- 1) Current resume (limited to 2 pages) with name, school affiliations (if any), past exhibition history (if any), and any past awards/memberships. Do not include any contact information
- 2) Artist's Statement (limited to 1 page)
- 3) 2 images of additional artworks not included in the show

PICK UP DATES:

WORKS MUST BE COLLECTED ON Sunday, October 8th 6-8pm or Monday, October 9th 12-6pm

If work is not picked up by specified date, Artist is subject to \$10/day storage fees.

The WAH Center is not responsible for works left after 30 days.
