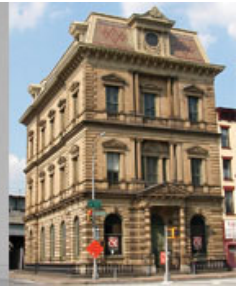

Instruction Details for Accepted

Show Dates: Saturday, November 7 – Sunday, December 6, 2015

Opening Reception: Saturday, November 7, 4-6PM

Gallery Hours: Friday – Sunday, 12-6 PM

REQUIREMENTS FOR ACCEPTED WORK:

- 1) A completed entry form (please see attachments)
- 2) Paid submission fees: \$20 submission fee for 1 piece, \$5 for each additional piece. The maximum number of submissions is 3. **Check made payable to: WAH Center, 135 Broadway, Brooklyn, NY 11211).**
- 3) Please have work signed (and numbered, if applicable) on back and front
- 4) Accepted works should be framed (unless otherwise arranged)
- 5) A label must be affixed to the back of the work, indicating which end is the top and the following: Artist's name, Title, Medium, Dimensions, Date Produced, Edition # (if applicable), and Sale Price. This information must correspond to the submitted works listed on the completed entry form
- 6) We do not accept pieces too fragile to handle
- 7) Artwork must be priced to sell
- 8) Works cannot be withdrawn before the end of the exhibition

DELIVERY INSTRUCTIONS:

Hand Delivery Dates: **Monday, November 2, 12-5 PM**
Tuesday, November 3, 6-9 PM

Deliver work to side entrance on Bedford Avenue:

- 1) Ring bell for admittance
- 2) Bring artwork to the 2nd floor gallery & check in at reception desk
- 3) Artwork must be clearly labeled on the front and back
- 4) Take all wrapping materials with you, as we do not have additional storage space
- 5) If you are delivering editions of a print, please bring any plastic protective sheets, envelopes, etc. that you would like to keep them in. One edition copy will be exhibited, the others will be kept in the gallery so that more than one edition is available for purchase.

EXHIBITION BINDER:

For viewers interested in knowing more about the exhibiting artists, we compile an exhibition binder containing information of participating artists. We ask for the following in plastic protective sheets (USA standard 8.5" x11", 3 punched holes):

- 1) Current resume (limited to 2 pages) with your name at the top. Do not include any contact information
- 2) Artist's Statement (limited to 1 page)
- 3) 2 images of additional artworks not included in the show
